





Ulrich's Periodicals Directory (ISSN 0000-0175, and ISSN 0000-2100) is the standard library directory and database providing information about popular and academic magazines, scientific journals, newspapers and other serial publications. UlrichWeb provide database about journals and is useful for identifying journals in a subject area, check if they are peer reviewed and in what database they are indexed or available in full text.UlrichWeb is subsidiary to ProQuest.

## **Usage of Ulrichs Web**

To determine if a journal peer-reviewed.

To determine what journal to submit articles for publication.

To find some journals in your field to use as a starting point in a literature search.

To determine information about the journals .publisher, editors etc.

## Coverage

Academic and scholarly journals (all types); open access publications, peer-reviewed titles; popular magazines, newspapers, newsletters; conference proceedings; regularly published publications, available free, small publishers, large commercial publishers, and not-for-profit publishers.

## To find Peer-reviewed Journal

You can check by looking up the journal title (NOT the title of the article) in a database called UlrichsWeb. Look for the referee's shirt next to the journal title. This will tell you whether or not the journal is peer-reviewed (Peer-reviewed articles may also be called scholarly, academic, or refereed).
